

# Add It Up



Learning our addition and subtraction facts is very important in 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. They need to know these to be prepared for their Math MAP test in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade. This bag is a way to make practicing these facts fun.

1. Read the book 12 Ways to Make 11 and talk about how they added in different ways.
2. Use the flash cards and make a game of practicing facts. For example, lay out the cards red side up and have the students find two cards that would have the same answer.
3. Use the number cubes to complete the worksheet and create problems to solve. Students can use the butterflies to check their answers.
4. Write facts on the white board or create them using the magnetic numbers on the magnetic board.
5. Choose a problem and write a math problem to match it in the bound notebook. At the top, put your name and date so we know who wrote it. You can also try solving other students' problems.
